Examples of how it works

Example 1:

Honoring a beloved pet

Karin and John want to honor and celebrate "Gator", their wonderful chihuahua, papillon mix, who passed away recently, by donating to an animal rescue. They simply contact a participating rescue organization and provide them the following:

- The monetary donation.
 (minimum amounts may be set)
- Their choice of dog or cat, or other species if applicable, to be named.
- The Name "Gator" of course.
- Their tribute message.

The Rescue organization selects one of their adoptable dogs and names him Gator for the special day! They then post his photo and John and Karin's tribute message on their social media sites.

Karin and John can now extend the reach and impact of their donation by commenting and posting photos of their own "Gator" to the Rescue's facebook site thereby spreading the word about the new Gator looking for a forever home.
